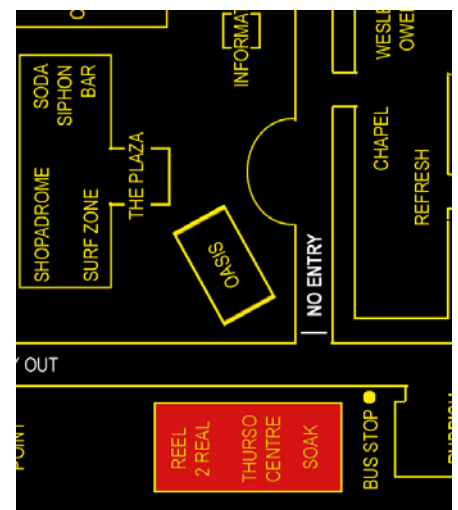
## SOAK
