**The Tonight Show with Simon Dean** – Get ready for more upfront and personal interviews with this weekend's must-see people! A big name act has been confirmed to appear.

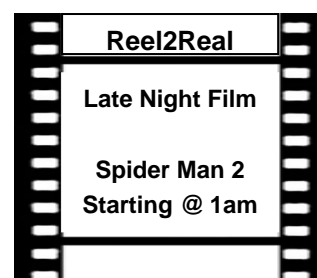
