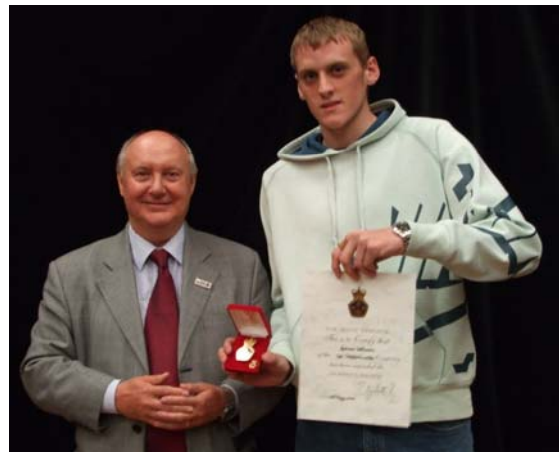
### RAIN DOWN
